6. Can I get my prescription at any Ritzman Pharmacy, whether it is in Buehler's or not?

Yes, that is one of the benefits. You can get your prescriptions at any Ritzman Pharmacy, whether in a Buehler's Fresh Foods or not. Currently though, you will only receive Buehler's Advantage Card Free Grocery Rewards on your prescriptions purchased at a Ritzman Pharmacy located within a Buehler's Fresh Foods.

7. Will I continue to earn Buehler's Advantage Card Free Grocery Rewards on my prescription purchases?
